

Andy Jones Tops Zimmerman Tanzer, & Pellon at Ice Age 50

A large and strong field again challenged the beautiful, rolling hills of the Ice Age Trail. The weather was cool in the early morning, but the sun and hot temperatures definitely became a factor in the second half of the race.

Pre-race favorite and course record-holder Tom Zimmerman took the lead from the start. Herb Tanzer, Andy Jones, Scott Larson, and Dick Dodd stayed hot on his heels through the first eight miles. By 15 miles, Zimmerman, Jones, and Tanzer were all within a minute of each other, with the rest of the early challengers starting to settle back. Jones then took the lead and worked hard through 24 miles to open a five-minute gap on Zimmerman, with Tanzer dropping to eight minutes back.

At 30 miles Zimmerman missed a turn, and subsequently dropped out. Andy Jones went on to increase his lead and set a new course record of 5:53. Jones, who is from Appleton, Wisconsin, has excellent road speed (sub-2:20 marathoner), but his trail experience is limited to only a couple of training runs. With his performance here Andy made believers out of a lot of experienced trail runners. But remember, Andy, they know who you are now.

In the women's division Randi Bromka from Aspen, Colorado, and Sherry Popowski from St. Joseph, Minnesota, stayed close through eight miles. Then Randi broke away to a seven-minute lead at 20 miles. She continued to run well, winning in 8:04.

Two hundred and sixteen runners finished within the twelve-hour limit, so earning the coveted Ice Age 50 buckle. Custom-designed wood plaques, with buckles mounted on it, were presented to all age group winners, which included Howard Henry, the oldest competitor at age 67.

Race director Don Ayer should be commended for another race well done. We all know it's not easy to put close to 300 runners on a 50-mile trail and keep everyone happy. But I guess Don gets a lot of practice as race director of Al's Run in Milwau-

kee, a race with over 29,000 entries.
